

Private views and evening openings at One Paved Court. You are very welcome to attend any of these evenings. We ask that people rsvp to the invitations we put out simply so that we can keep a track of numbers and plan accordingly.

You do not have to know the artist beforehand. It can be very nerve-wracking putting on a solo exhibition and the artists always really appreciate it when new people show their support by attending the private view/evening opening.

The events are an opportunity to see the show early on, meet the artist if you would like to, and enjoy the exhibition in a relaxed social atmosphere. You do not need to arrive at the start time. Arrive at any time between 6 – 8pm and stay as long or as little as you like. Drinks are usually served.

Artist Talks at One Paved Court are free and open to everyone regardless of your art background (or lack of one). You don't need to rsvp.

They vary in format but in general are very informal and usually involve a short talk by the artist where they explain the work on show and give you an insight into their way of working. They may also talk about other work they have done and a little about their background. There is always the opportunity to ask questions if you would like to. Not everyone wants to but it is always interesting listening to others' questions. Students of all ages are particularly encouraged to attend.

In total the whole session lasts less than an hour although you are welcome to stay longer and look at the exhibition again/talk to the artist privately if you wish to. Don't worry if you arrive a bit late - just come in and join the audience.

During the talks photographs and videos are often taken for use on our social media - if you do not want to be filmed please let us know beforehand if possible.
